## Helpful Tips

- Manager-Target of Investigation or on-going case?
- Call your Chapter Member Representative
- Take good notes.
- Keep answers short and precise
- Answer questions to the best of your ability.
- Request a break if you need to consult with Rep.

# OIG/PI Investigative Interview

## Helpful Tips

- You may be asked to sign paper that your rights were read (Not an Admission of Guilt).
- Ask: “Can this lead to Criminal Charges?”
- If Yes, STOP!
- Say nothing else- Call an Attorney.
- Rep can be used as Technical Advisor.
