You Can Make A Difference

One of the awesome benefits of UPMA membership is the ability to network with other UPMA members. I was a member for many years before I took advantage of this benefit and it has truly made a difference in my career, not only in my personal growth but also in my advancement. Attending UPMA events gives you access to a wealth of knowledge and friendship. Getting involved will open new doors you may not even realize exist.

I have attended Legislative Conventions and spoken to members of congress for the last 10 years. It is a great feeling knowing that you made a difference with your words and actions. It was very fulfilling when the Postal Reform Act was passed. Had the management organizations not been pursuing this, I don't know that it would have come to pass. That was a big hurdle, but there is still more we need to get done. This year's Legislative Convention is March 19-22. Because of the importance of getting members to talk to Congress, UPMA will reimburse verifiable expenses up to \$500* when you attend. We get a much better audience with members of Congress when we have someone from their district with us. This is a busy few days, but there is still time for networking and some sightseeing. You can even add a day to your trip if you wish to do even more.

National Convention this year is in Denver, Colorado August 26-31. This is a chance to meet with members from all across the nation. There are training classes and speakers from headquarters and the UPMA national office. Again, the Illinois

Chapter will be reimbursing up to \$500 in verifiable expenses* to any regular or retired member that wishes to attend. Bringing a friend to share a room with is a great way to reduce your expenses and makes it more fun too. There is usually a day free from meetings and group tours can be scheduled.

Closer to home, the Chapter Convention will be held in Bloomington, Illinois April 14-16. If you register by March 1, 2023, your registration fee will be refunded to you*. This year, elections will be held for Secretary, Treasurer, and one Vice President position. As a regular member, you are eligible to run for these positions. The retirees will also be electing a Retiree President. Any retired member is eligible to run. You can contact any current board member if you would like more information about any of these positions or the convention in general.

Even if you can't get away for any of the conventions, you can still make a difference by doing other things like recruiting members, writing articles for the newsletter, or presenting on Zoom meetings. Contact any board member for ways you can be involved.

*Attendance is required at all general sessions and two training classes when presented.

Money Matters

The Illinois board made some decisions concerning our finances. We voted to reimburse members, including retirees, up

to \$500.00 in verifiable expenses to attend the 2023 Legislative Summit in Washington, DC. The summit will be held March 19, 2023 through March 22, 2023. You will find the registration form for the event in this issue. I strongly urge you to attend as we convey the needs of our employees and retirees to our congressmen. Nothing changes without constituents pleading their cases. UPMA needs you to help represent us in DC!

Also coming up soon is our annual Chapter Convention, which will be held April 14 through April 16 in Bloomington, IL. The registration form for this event is in this issue. If you send your registration in by March 1, 2023 and attend the entire convention, the fee will be reimbursed. There are 3 board positions that will need to be filled at this convention. After 12 years as your treasurer, I am stepping down from this position. Last year I retired and I feel it's time to transfer my skills and support to the retiree section of this great organization! Along with the treasurer position, you will also be electing a secretary and a vice president. Anyone interested in running for a position is encouraged to do so! Please join us in April to conduct the business of Illinois UPMA , attend educational classes, network with your peers and have some fun!

The final event I would like to mention is National Convention. This year we will be traveling to Denver, Colorado for our 7th Annual UPMA National Convention. My first national convention was in Denver in 2003 and I've attended nearly every national convention since. It has been amazing hearing our PMGs speak. I've learned so much at the training offered each year and I've enjoyed networking with postmasters from all over the United States. National Convention is truly an event no one should miss. This year Illinois UPMA is offering up to \$500.00 reimbursement of verifiable traveling expenses to all active members and retirees attending this convention. So mark your calendars, make your arrangements, and join us in Colorado August 27th through September 1st.

Since we have so many new members attending events, I wanted to reiterate the reimbursement process. The expenses eligible for reimbursement are registration, airfare and baggage, mileage to/from airport, gas receipts if driving, hotel, and transportation fare to meetings with congressmen. These expenses must be recorded on a stipend voucher for non-board members with receipts attached. There is a separate voucher for board members. These vouchers can be found on the Illinois UPMA website. Your name badge can be used as the receipt for registration. Actual receipts are required for all other expenses. Vouchers and receipts should be mailed to Earl Husbands for his approval. He will then mail them to me for payment. Expenses are required to be submitted within 30 days of the actual event. Late submission will require board approval for payment.

President Earl will be issuing travel orders for board members four to six weeks before each upcoming UPMA event. Travel orders will also be issued for members at large that are approved to attend. Airline tickets are not to be purchased until the receipt of the travel order unless otherwise instructed by Earl. We also voted to require prior approval of the President for the purchase of any ticket exceeding \$500.00. Please keep these new requirements in mind when planning future UPMA travel.
